Instructions & Disclosures for Claiming Nursing Contact Hours

Registered attendees meeting eligibility requirements may earn **up to 14 contact hours**¹ for attending podium presentation(s), poster presentation(s), and workshop(s) and by completing the below steps **before Monday, December 15, 2025, 12noon ET:**

1. Attend the entire concurrent session and/or workshop to earn associated contact hour(s). View poster group(s) to earn associated contact hour(s).
2. Claim contact hours **and obtain handouts** via the online platform. Access by scanning **QR code** or go to <https://bit.ly/2025ANCCFallConference>(case sensitive) using your badge number and last name.
 - After a session ends, find it on the online platform using the **Browse Sessions** or **Search** option. Click on session title. Click **“Claim CNE Credit”**.
 - Submit attestation statement to earn associated contact hours for that session. *Repeat this process for each session attended.*
3. Once completed, click **“Review Claimed CNE”** to obtain and **save your contact hours certificate.**
