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- A pressure ulcer prevention program.
- A comprehensive model aimed to reduce pressure ulcer incidence and management.



# Objectives....

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- Reduce hospital acquired pressure ulcer incident rate.
- Enhance staff education.
- Provide a comprehensive set practice guideline.
- Empower nursing staff.
- Improve patient outcomes.



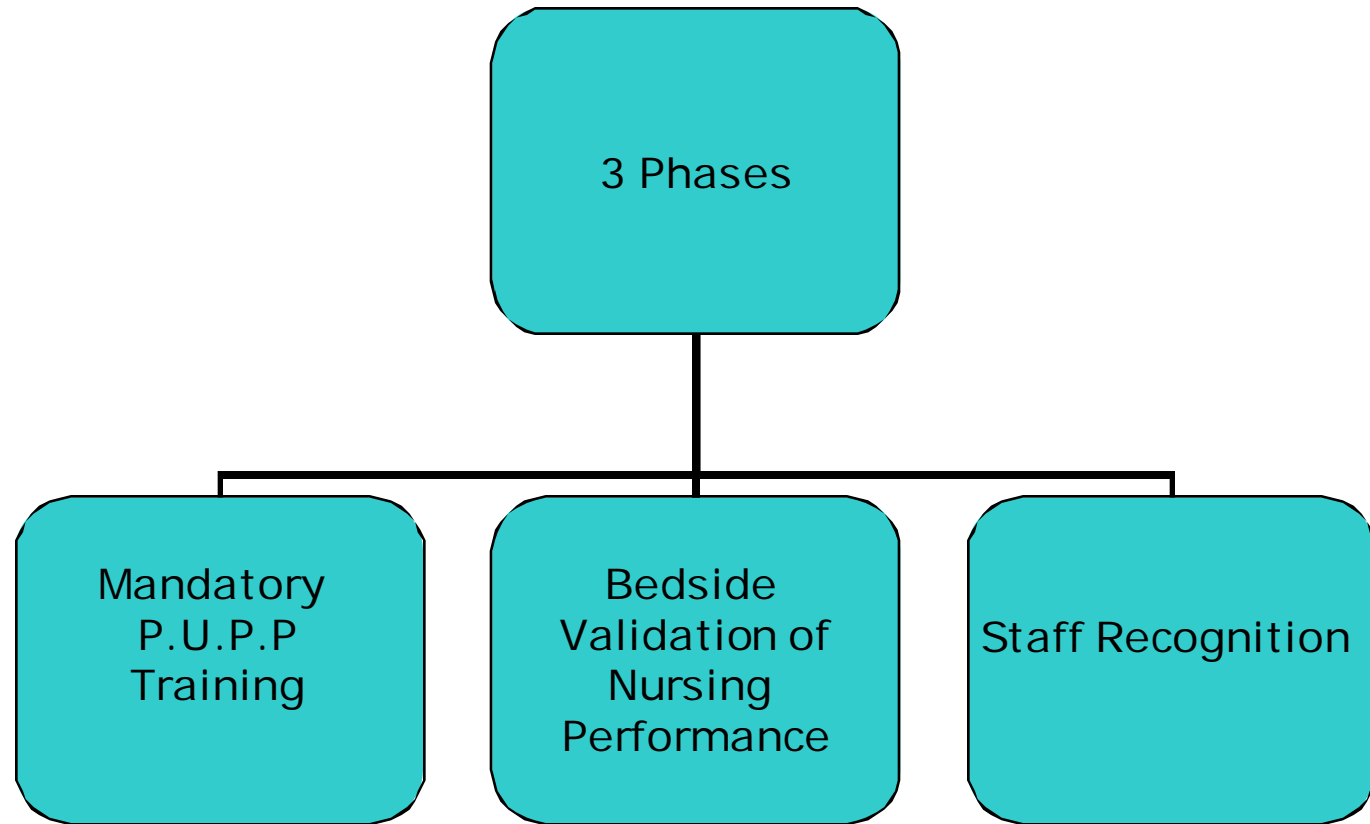

# Program Implementation

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## How does this work ?

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- Mandatory classes with pre and post-testing.
- Unit-based product formulary in servicing.
- Monthly “in house” pressure ulcer surveys.
- Bedside evaluation of nursing performance.
- Staff recognition.



# Program Roll-Out

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- Northwest Hospital-242 bed community acute care facility.
- The P.U.P.P was initiated November, 2009 –March, 2010 over a 4month period.
- 100% Acute Care Services-inpatient unit participation



## In-House Survey Data during P.U.P.P initiative

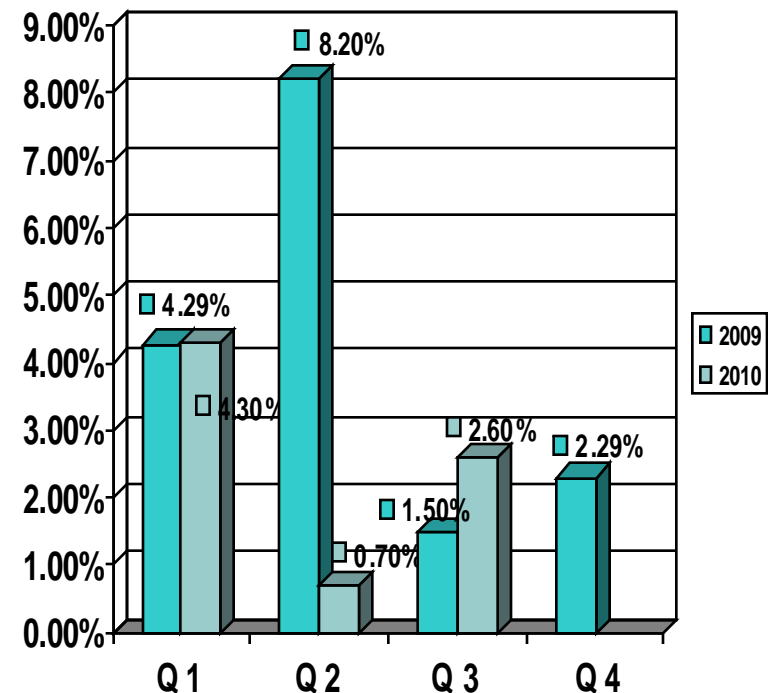
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- January, 2010- 3.9% incident rate
- February, 2010- 2.3% incident rate
- March, 2010-2.5% incident rate

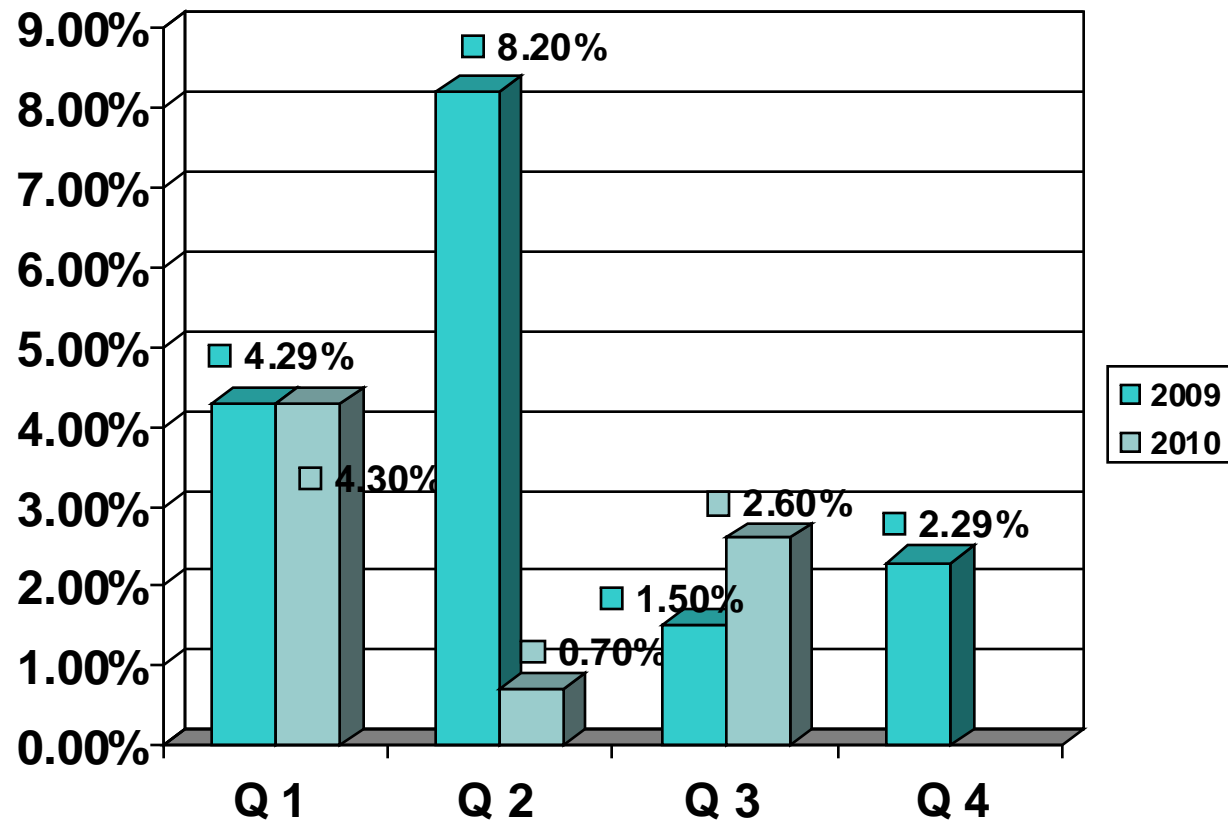


# Reported NDNQI Survey Data...

- Facility benchmark-8.6%
- Overall average reduction rate decreased from 14% in 2008 to current 2.5% ending 2010.
