- Improve patient outcomes.







# In-House Survey Data during P.U.P.P initiative


January,2010- 3.9% incident rate

March,2010-2.5% incident rate






## Reported NDNQI Survey Data...

- Facility benchmark-8.6%
- Overall average reduction rate decreased from14% in 2008 to current 2.5% ending 2010.
