






Search Process

- EBSCO: CINAHL & MEDLINE
- Terms: implicit ration*; miss* care; ration* care; task* undone; unfinish* care
- 54/1375 Papers met eligibility criteria:
 - -Hospital setting
 - -Conceptual definitions and/or analysis
 - -Original qualitative & quantitative research
 - -Instrument development and/or evaluation
 - -Literature reviews







Prevalence & Antecedents

- High Prevalence
- -50-97% report leaving ≥ 1 activities unfinished
- -Mean ranges 6-22 activities
- -Occurs across all categories of nursing care
- · 2 Consistently Identified Antecedents
 - -Nurse staffing
 - -Team behaviors

Associated Outcomes

- Patients
 - ·Lower quality of care
 - Adverse events
 - Mortality
 - · Lower satisfaction
- Nurses
 - Job/occupation satisfaction
 - Turnover/Intent to stay
- A stronger predictor of patient outcomes than nurse staffing indices

Patterns of Unfinished Care

Most Often

- Emotional support
- Education
- Coordination & Discharge Planning
- Care Planning
- Timeliness of intervention

Least Often

- Infection control
- Treatments, tests, procedures
- Providing Nutrition
- Assisting with Elimination

How Nurses Prioritize

- Maslow effect
- Visible & temporal outcome effect
- Time cost effect
- Collective cooperation effect
- Audit effect

Limitations & Recommendations

- Limitations
 - -Observational Study Designs
 - -Relatively Few Primary Samples
 - -Potential for Instrument Bias
 - -Potential for Common Method/Source Bias
- Recommendations
 - -Research, Practice, Education, Policy
